## **MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF 50<sup>TH</sup> GENERAL BODY OF NCTE HELD ON 29.09.2020**

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The 50<sup>th</sup> meeting of the General Body of NCTE was held through Virtual Mode on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2020, at 11.00 am. The list of the members who attended the meeting is attached at **Annexure-1**.

At the outset, the Chairperson NCTE welcomed the members of the General Body of NCTE, who are meeting first time after, its reconstitution. Thereafter, agenda items were taken up for discussion and the following decisions taken by the General Body.

With the permission of Chair, Sh. T. Pritam Singh, Deputy Secretary, NCTE presented the Agenda before the Council.

### **Agenda Item No. 1 Confirmation of the Minutes and Action Taken Report of 49<sup>th</sup> General Body Meeting of NCTE held on circulation.**

The Minutes of the 49<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the General Body of NCTE were circulated to all the Members, the minutes of the 49<sup>th</sup> General Body of NCTE have been confirmed.

2. The Action Taken report of the 49<sup>th</sup> General Body of NCTE was presented before the Council and the same was noted and confirmed.

### **Agenda Item No. 2 Discontinuation of Standing Committee for recommendation of application for grant of Innovative Teacher Education Programme.**

The agenda was discussed at length and it was pointed out by the members that the innovation is phenomena which continues in any circumstance, therefore, the rationale given that the main activity under innovative category is now subsumed in extant Regulations is not acceptable. Therefore, the Council did not agree to discontinue the Standing Committee on Innovative programmes, however, the composition of the present Standing Committee on innovation course may be changed by way of reconstituting a the Committee inducting new members from the academic field. Accordingly, Chairperson, NCTE was authorised to constitute a new Standing Committee on behalf of Council.

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### **Agenda Item No: 3 Consideration for Re-constitution of Appeal Committee**

The agenda was considered by the Council and after detailed discussions on various aspects as also the new proposal for constituting the new Appeal Committee, the Council agreed for constituting the new Appeal Committee with the Composition as proposed in Agenda Note including one officer not below the rank of Under Secretary from NCTE.

It was suggested that representative of the concerned RCs may also be present in the Appeal Committee meetings if the circumstances so require.

The following will be the composition of the Appeals Committee :-

- One member of the Council as Chairperson of the Appeal Committee, to be decided by Chairperson, NCTE;
- At least one member among the nine members of the Council appointed to represent the States and the Union Territory Administrations.
- Two other members of the Council as members of the Appeal Committee.
- One representative of the concerned Regional Committee, if the circumstances so requires.

*(Secretarial Assistance to the Appeal Committee shall be provided by the Appeal Division of the NCTE)*

The Council authorised the Chairperson, NCTE to constitute the Appeal Committee, as per the above composition.

### **Agenda Item No. 4: Consideration of Annual Report of NCTE for the year 2019-20**

The Annual Report of NCTE for the year 2019-2020 was approved.

### **Agenda Item No. 5: Ratification of relaxation granted under Clause 12 of NCTE, Regulations, 2014 by the Chairperson, NCTE, New Delhi.**

The Council ratified the action taken by Chairperson, NCTE under clause 12 of NCTE Regulations 2014 in granting relaxation to the two colleges namely (1) Kinag Nongbah Government College, Jowai, Meghalaya (2) DIET, Bijapur, Dantewada, Chhattisgarh.

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**Agenda Item No. 6: Consideration of the issue related to minimum qualification for appointment as Assistant Professor and reduction of number of posts in existing teacher education institutions recognised by NCTE.**

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and since the NEP recommends three types of teacher education courses, namely 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme, 2-year B.Ed. and 1 year B.Ed., in light of this proposition, it was perceived that the qualification as were prescribed in the Regulations, 2014 and the number of faculty as was required at that point of time would not have relevance. Therefore, after due deliberations, the agenda item was dropped.

**Agenda Item No. 7: Consideration of the Issue related to extension of Validity of Teacher Eligibility Test from Seven years to Life time.**

The Council considered the agenda item and approved the validity of TET certificate changing it from 7 years to the Life time. This provision would have prospective effect and for those have already passed out (already having TET certificate), NCTE would take legal opinion and will act accordingly.

**Agenda Item No.8 : Consideration of the issue related to revision of the Norms and Standards of the existing 3 years Integrated B.Ed -M.Ed degree course for appearing in TET and employment as School teacher**

The agenda was discussed in detail and it was decided to constitute a Committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. Vandana Saxena, CIE, Delhi. The Committee will submit its report by 9.10.2020. The report so submitted would be made available to all the members of the Council through circulation for their perusal. The Council also authorised the Chairperson, NCTE get notified the revised version of Norms and Standards which will ratified by the Council in next meeting.

**Agenda Item No- 9 : Audited Annual Accounts of NCTE for the Financial year 2019-20**

The Annual Accounts for the Financial Year 2019-20 have been first passed by the Finance Committee and same have been placed before the Council for approval before conducting CAG Audit. The same were approved by the Council.



**The Council also discussed the following issues besides the circulated Agenda:-**

1. It was decided that NCTE will create a Whatsapp group for members of the General Body of NCTE, which will enable them to interact / communicate among themselves for any suggestion, change and information as required from time to time.
2. It was decided that the Council Members will discuss among themselves and come out with some concrete suggestions for the improvement of teacher education sector enabling NCTE to implement in light of NEP.
3. The issue relating to qualification of Aanganwadi workers were also discussed. Members are requested to provide some more details in this regard to enable the NCTE to frame guidelines in accordance with NCTE Regulations.
